As we move into the final stretch of the school year, I want to take a moment to recognize the work happening across our district every day.

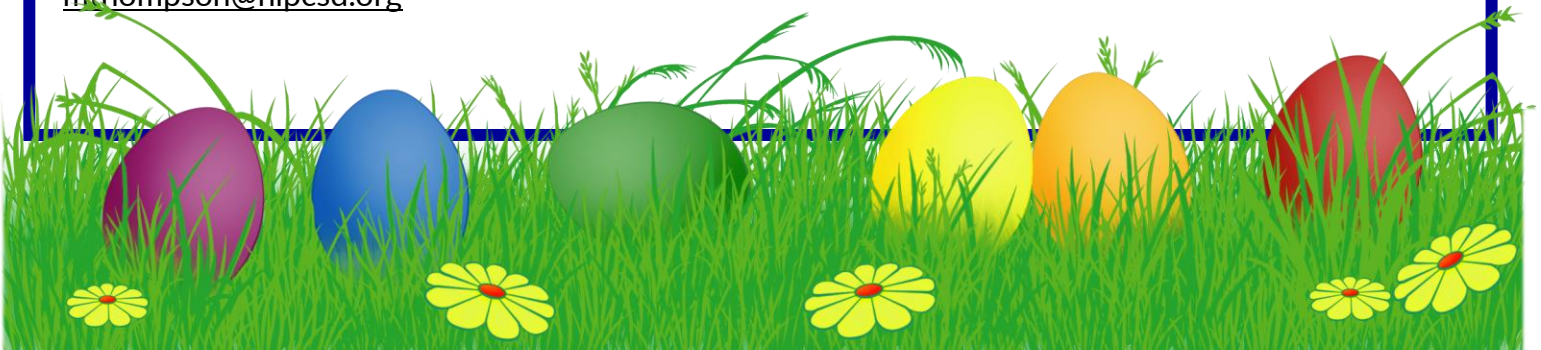


